

Environmental Day-2021 Celebration

Environmental Day-2021 on 5th June was celebrated by planting saplings of various tree species under the leadership of Prof. H. S. Yadav, Director, NERIST, Nirjuli-791109, Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh. More than 280 plant saplings of various tree species like Bokul *Mimusops elengi* (40 nos.), Khokon *Duabanga grandiflora* (40 nos.), Ashok *Saraca asoca* (50 nos.), Jackfruits *Artocarpus heterophyllus* (100 nos.) and Bahera *Terminalia bellirica* (50 nos.) including fruits bearing plants were planted in the road sides of the campus, Gas Agency area, surrounding new 24 classrooms building as well as in the existing green zones area's openings.
