Now whereas, it is agreed between the parties that

- Both the parties shall assist each other in undertaking their respective academic activities through making faculty and other support available for the purpose.
- ii) Both the parties shall undertake joint research, study visits, content/curriculum development, development of training aids

- iii) Both the parties shall suitably advise their respective affiliates/associates to undertake activities/measures as may be useful for promotion of activities of both the parties and/or joint activities.
- iv) Both the parties shall regularly share the relevant information and make their respective library/literary facilities available to each other for due performance of the agreed activities.
- V) IIE being the pioneer in the field of skill development initiatives across NER shall facilitate the skill building of the unemployed youth through standardised entrepreneurship and skill development programmes sponsored by the Ministry of MSME, Government of India. The Deemed University shall conduct the same through its different competent departments/ campuses/ study centres/ affiliated colleges and institutions. The vocational trainings courses shall be suggested by the Deemed University for one Financial Year/ Calendar Year as per requirement and forward the same to the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Government of India for necessary sponsorship through IIE.
- vi) Both the parties shall sponsor its Faculty/Support Staff to the development courses etc. being run by the other party.
- vii) Both the parties shall share the information which may come in its knowledge/possession as may be useful either for the joint activities or activities of the either party.
- viii) Both the parties shall undertake all the feasible measures for promoting the activities of the other party.
- ix) Both the parties shall hold regular meetings for identifying the areas of specific joint action/collaboration and reviewing the progress of the on-going activities.

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x) The financial and other details of the activities shall be as may be mutually decided.

This MOU may be terminated by either party after giving 30 days' notice of its intention to so terminate the MOU. However, notwithstanding the termination of the MOU, both the parties shall continue to remain responsible for their respective obligations in respect of all the activities which might have already been undertaken prior to termination or then going-on.

AND

Rajiv Gandhi University, through its authorized representative, Registrar, Rajiv Gandhi University, Rono Hills, Doimukh, Arunachal Pradesh, is a central university established under the "The Rajiv Gandhi University Act, 2006", with the registered office at Rono Hills, Doimukh, Arunachal Pradesh 791112, (herein after referred to as RGU).

1. Preamble

RGU is a central University with a rich resource base in scientific manpower and NERIST is a premier multidisciplinary Research and Development Institute, covering areas such as Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electronics and Communications, Department of Forestry, Computer Science, Agricultural Engineering and MBA. Sharing a common desire

to explore, extend and strengthen the functional relationship between **RGU** and **NERIST**, in order to share the facilities and expertise available in each other's institution herewith sign a Memorandum of Understanding.

2. Purpose and Objectives

The purpose of this MoU is to promote institutional linkage between **NERIST** and **RGU** to create a platform to explore avenues for possible collaboration with specific objectives as given below:

- a. To establish a close linkage and functional coordination between RGU and NERIST.
- b. To consider the qualified faculty to conduct collaborative research and obtain funding for research by submitting joint project proposals for research and development, training and consultancy in India/abroad.
- Both institutions will extend scientific instrumentation facility to researchers of each other institutions as per availability.
- d. RGU & NERIST shall have faculty exchange programme to teach certain degree courses at each other's campuses. Scientists/faculty interested to participate in the exchange programme shall be paid TA/DA and Honorarium as per the guidelines of their respective institutions.
- e. On the mutual agreement, specialized and short duration refresher courses/training programs on the topic of interest to the industry/academia can be jointly offered at NERIST or RGU. The resources for such activities shall be shared.
- f. Both institutions shall also envisage and engage together on mutually agreed terms to have other forms of cooperation like hosting conferences, seminars etc. and for specifics of any program a separate Memorandum of Agreement may be drawn, if required.
- g. Any intellectual property arising out of the joint intellectual inputs under a collaborative R&D project will be shared jointly; and filing and maintenance cost, if any, shall be shared equally.
- h. None of the institutions shall alone file any application for seeking Intellectual Property rights on the outcome/information gathered from collaborative work or disclosed for such purpose in its own name or in the name of its associates or any other person(s).

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- i. NERIST and RGU shall consult each other for any publication arising from collaborative research work/course work. These publications shall be in the name of actively participating research worker, wherein it will be duly acknowledged that the work has been carried out at NERIST or RGU under the sponsorship of a particular funding agency.
- j. NERIST and RGU shall meet the expenses for their respective purposes and activities under this MoU from their own resources.
- k. Any expenditure incurred through the joint programs will be borne as per mutual agreement.

3. Special Provisions

- a. Both parties shall disseminate information related to each other's research activities and other programs on mutually agreed terms and conditions.
- b. Both parties hereto shall do their utmost to maintain close contact for ensuring smooth and efficient implementation of the activities to be taken up under the MoU.
- c. Both parties shall exert their best efforts to be available for mutual consultations and shall give each other such necessary information as reasonably as possible and agreed upon.
- d. Any amendment to this Memorandum of Understanding shall be made in writing and shall have to be mutually agreed upon by both the parties.
- e. All disputes arising in connection with the interpretation or application of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through mutual negotiations.
- Memorandum of Understanding shall be governed by and be construed in accordance with NERIST/RGU norms.

4. Duration of Program

This Memorandum shall come into force on the date of its signing by both parties and shall be in effect for a period of 03 (three) years. If MoU is to be terminated without cause, a three (3) months prior written notice shall be sent by one party to the other party. This MoU may be renewed by mutual written consent of both the institutions, with modifications and/or incorporation of additional clauses on mutually agreed to terms, if so desire by either of the institutions.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The North Eastern Regional Institute of Science & Technology, Nirjuli, Arunachal Pradesh, India (hereinafter referred to as NERIST) and American University of Sharjah (hereinafter referred to AUS), collectively referred to as the 'Institutions' or the 'Parties'

RECOGNIZING their mutual interest in science, medical and engineering research, development, education and technology transfer on a non-commercial basis

HEREBY agree to encourage collaboration according to the terms and conditions set forth in the following articles.

I. Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to provide a framework of cooperation and facilitate collaboration between the parties, on a non-exclusive basis, in areas of mutual interest in the United Arab Emirates.

II. Areas of Cooperation

Article 1: Fields of collaboration

NERIST and AUS may collaborate within any mutually agreeable field of science, medical and engineering research and education.

Article 2: Exchange of faculty, scientific staff, and students

2.1 Exchange of faculty and scientific staff.

- 2.1.1 The administrations of the two institutions agree to assist their respective faculty members/scientific staff in developing scholarly exchanges that may include a range of interaction such as research collaboration, specialized lectures, seminars, teaching, and joint-venture start-up companies, etc.
- 2.1.2 Both parties undertake to care, as far as possible, for the needs of visitors from the partner institution and to assist them in finding suitable accommodation.
- 2.1.3 The home institution will continue to pay the salary of faculty members/scientific staff during their stay at the host institution. The host institution will make no salary payments to the visiting member of staff. Both institutions will make efforts to compensate faculty members/scientific staff for any extra expenditure incurred.
- 2.1.4 The home institution or the faculty members/scientific staff will be personally responsible for travel expenses. However, funds from sponsored/consultancy projects in either institution may be used for travel purposes.

2.2 Exchange of students

- 2.2.1 Consistent with the requirements of the project/thesis work of a student, both institutions will enable the exchange of undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students. The number of students for exchange programs will be decided based on mutual agreement between faculties of the institutions.
- 2.2.2 Student exchange is possible during semester breaks, or short holidays during semesters. However, students having only thesis/project work can avail themselves of student exchange facilities at any time, subject to the policies of their respective home institution in connection with their thesis/project work. Only the home institution will evaluate and award grades to such students (as appropriate).
- 2.2.3 The home institution will continue to pay assistantship monies to students (if appropriate) during their stay at the host institution. The host institution may not pay assistantship monies to such students. However, both institutions will make efforts to compensate students for any additional expenditure that may be incurred. For students not receiving assistantships from any source, both institutions will make an effort to pay assistantship monies from sources such as sponsored or consultancy projects, etc.
- 2.2.4 The student will be personally responsible for travel expenses. However, funds from any sponsored/consultancy projects in any institution may be used for travel purposes, if available.



- 2.2.5 The host institution will provide basic healthcare requirements and logistical support to the student for the purposes of carrying out the thesis/project work. Students may be allowed to stay in the hostels of host institutions as per the rules of the host institution.
- 2.2.6 Faculty members of both institutions may be considered co-supervisors of students on a case by case basis.

Article 3: Research Projects

- 3.1 Research collaboration in areas of mutual interest to both institutions, including submission of joint research proposals to funding agencies.
- 3.2 Exchange of scientific material which is made available by both institutions.
- 3.3 Interested faculty of either institution may initiate joint research projects. Subject to available funding, the institutions will encourage research centers of their respective institutions to initiate and conduct collaborative projects consistent with the other terms and specifications of this agreement. Such joint research projects are to be the subject of definitive project agreements specific to each project and separate from this MOU.
- 3.4 Funds for research projects will be administered by the host institution. The financial arrangements relating to each joint research project will be in accordance with the specific agreement covering each project.
- 3.5 Institutions will also make efforts to sponsor co-operative seminars, workshops and other meetings on matters of mutual interest, in addition to joint-venture (if possible).

Article 4: Intellectual Property, Inventions and Innovations

The terms with respect to title to and exploitation of intellectual property, inventions and innovations (including but not limited to trademarks and service marks, copyrights, patents, designs and confidential information on the subject of such intellectual property, inventions and innovations) will be negotiated on a project-by-project basis in the specific research project agreements referred to in Article 3.

III. Communication and Exchange of Information

- 3.1 The parties shall, on a regular basis, keep each other informed of and consult on matters of common interest, which in their opinion are likely to lead to mutual collaboration.
- 3.2 Both institutions will agree upon the specific terms of any inter-institution initiative relative to this agreement in written or electronic record correspondence at least two months prior to the initiation of a particular program or activity in order for the said initiative to proceed.

IV. Implementation Arrangements

- 4.1 When the parties wish to enter into a further specific co-operation (projects, special events etc.) within the framework of the MOU, the parties will sign a separate project-specific agreement, which will stipulate the obligations of the parties with respect to such co-operation. Any project-specific agreement will be concluded and carried out in accordance with this MOU, and will include a provision referring to the MOU, which is applicable to such agreements and the programs / projects resulting there-from.
- 4.2 In itself, this MOU will not carry any financial obligations for either party.

V. Use of Name and Logo

- 5.1 Neither party will use the name, logo or trademarks of the other party, or any abbreviation thereof, in connection with its business or otherwise without the express prior written approval of the other party in each case.
- 5.2 Each party acknowledges that it is familiar with ideals and objectives of the other party and recognizes that its name and logo may not be used in a manner inconsistent with the status and reputation of the other party.
- 5.3 The parties agree to recognize and acknowledge this partnership as appropriate. To this end, the parties shall consult with each other concerning the matter and the form of such recognition and acknowledgement.
- 5.4 Neither party shall speak or make public statements on behalf of the other or claim to represent the other, except in specific cases where express agreement is given in writing.

VI. Statutory Compliance

6.1 Each party will cooperate in the activities envisaged under this MOU in accordance with their own internal regulations, rules, and directives. Specific activities envisioned under this MOU that require financial commitments or liabilities of either party will be subject to separate written agreements.

VII. Duration of the Agreement, Termination and Modification

- 7.1 This agreement will enter into force for an initial period of five years, on the date of its signature by the duly authorized representatives of the parties.
- 7.2 Either party may terminate the arrangements described in this MOU upon one month's notice in writing to the other party. In the event of termination, the parties will take steps to bring the activities under the MOU to a prompt and orderly conclusion. Activities commenced under separate arrangements concluded under the MOU may also be terminated as agreed between the parties. In the event of breach of any terms of the MOU, it may be terminated without notice.
- 7.3 This agreement may be amended by mutual consent, provided that one of the parties notifies the other in writing of the proposed amendment.

VIII. Privileges

8.1 Nothing in or relating to this MOU shall be deemed a waiver, expressed, or implied of any of the privileges.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, Institutions have agreed to associate themselves with the aim of promoting academic co-operation for mutual interest

THEREFORE, Institutions agree to the following:

- Faculty members from NERIST, Nirjuli, deputed by their administration may be allowed to take for 1. credit/courses being taught at IIT Guwahati. The courses so credited will be accepted as meeting the course requirements of NERIST, Nirjuli, of their Ph.D. programme.
- Such students will not have to pay tuition fees at IIT Guwahati for the courses they credit. 2.
