He also informed that after getting Deemed University status, this was the first Academic Council meeting at the Institute.

Having felicitated the External Members, the Chairman requested both the internal and the external Members to introduce themselves. All members introduced themselves.

While all the external Members affirmed their role to take part in the Academic Council meetings especially to strengthen the academic system and to ensure that the Society is directly benefited, the Chairman reminded that Academic Council is the most important body of the Institute to discuss and resolve academic matters pertaining to the development of Institute especially the teaching and learning system through which the pass out students would earn name and fame for themselves and also, for the Institute. He also emphasized that a lot of responsibilities are before us to bring the reputation of NERIST nationality and internationality through the wholehearted efforts of all faculty, students and staffs. He also appealed to the Deans, HODs and other enlightened Members of the Academic Council to bring new and innovative ideas related to academic side for the overall development of the Institute.

The Council than took up one-by-one the Agenda items for deliberations. The gist of deliberations is recorded as follows:

A.C. 1.4 To consider the proposal for acceptance of Academic Bye Laws of the Institute

The proposal on Academic Bye Laws was unanimously approved with the following observations suggesting minor modifications:

- I. The admission to Ph.D. (Full Time) will be once in a year (say at the beginning of the academic session) but one can register to Ph.D (By Research: Part Time) at any time throughout the year.
- II. For admission to M.Tech./Ph.D (Full Time), the candidate is required to have a valid GATE/NET Score (70 for General and 60 for SC/ST/PH candidates).
- III. For examining the fees structure of PG Studies, a Committee is constituted as follows:
