4. Transfer Certificate/Institute Leaving Certificate from last college/Institute/University attended, as applicable. [Can be submitted after admission but within one month from date of admission]
5. Migration Certificate from the last attended University. [Can be submitted after admission but within one month from date of admission]
6. Aadhaar Card of the candidate.
7. GATE/NET/JRF etc Score Card, as applicable.
8. SC/ST/OBC(NCL)/EWS/PWD certificate issued by the Competent Authority, as applicable.
9. Parent/Legal Guardian's Income Certificate from the Competent Authority of the respective District. [Can be submitted after admission but within one month from date of admission]
10. Medical Fitness Certificate of the candidate as per the format as available on the website.

STEPS FOR FILLING UP THE ONLINE COUNSELLING CUM ADMISSION FORM FOR PG/Ph.D CANDIDATES

1. Visit <https://students.targetx.in/NERIST/> on or after 1st June 2026.
2. First time click on "Apply Now" tab and register with your valid email address, OTP sent to your email, mobile number, program (carefully select the program you want admission to, based on which admission test you appeared; if you register for wrong program, your application will be cancelled; applications are not transferable among programs; in case you have applied in wrong program, you must register again with a new email address since only one application is allowed for one account and will have to pay the counselling fees again), preferred specialization (tentative, subject to availability during counselling), state, city, and set a password for logging in to your account later through <https://students.targetx.in/NERIST/login>. **PLEASE NOTE THAT THESE EMAIL ADDRESS AND MOBILE NUMBER WILL BE OFFICIALLY REGISTERED WITH US FOR ALL FUTURE CORRESPONDENCES TILL COMPLETION OF COURSE!**
3. Login to your account at <https://students.targetx.in/NERIST/login>.
4. If you are using mobile phone then switch on the Desktop View mode on mobile browser.
5. On the top of the screen, your application number along with program and percentage filled up will show. Note down the application number for future reference. If you have any query, click on the "Query" icon on the left pane and write your query, post it, and wait for reply by email. If you ask questions which are already answered here, you won't receive any response.
6. On the left panel you will see Instruction and Notification menus. Read the instructions carefully before filling up the form. And keep checking the notifications regularly for any update from us. Also visit NERIST website (<https://www.nerist.ac.in>) for updates. You can come back to complete your application anytime by clicking on "My Application" menu on the top panel.
7. Next click on the <Program> Admission 2026 menu to start filling up the form (<Program> stands for the program you have selected before).
8. The form has six sections: Personal Details, Educational Details, Entrance Examination Details, Bank Details, Parent/Guardian Details, and Docs & Signature. Mandatory fields are marked with *.
9. In Personal Details, upload a good quality recent photograph with white background (**max. 500 pixel high X 400 pixel wide**). This photo will be used in all official documents and identity card, if you get admitted to NERIST.
10. In Entrance Examination Details, fill up carefully the NEE/JEE/NEPGET details as written in NEE/JEE/NEPGET Admit Card and Published Result (<https://www.nerist.ac.in/results>) or JoSAA/CSAB-NEUT issued allotment letter. Any mistake here may cancel your application. If you are sponsored In-Service candidate for lateral entry to B.Tech program, write In-Service against NEE Roll Number and Rank, and select In-Service in "NEE Selection Category" field.
11. In Parent/Guardian Details, provide correct mobile number of your parents/guardians which we may use as alternate contact number in case your registered number is unreachable/unattended.
12. In the Documents and Signature section, upload your AADHAAR card photo or PDF (**without password protection**).
13. In the signature field, upload a good image file of YOUR actual signature (**max. 100 pixel high X 150 pixel wide**). This signature will be used in all official documents and identity card, if you get admitted to NERIST.
14. Next go to Preference on the left panel and click on the branches in sequence of your preference. Once clicked, you will see the order number of that branch in your preference list. To remove any branch from your preference selected by mistake, click on it again. Once satisfied with your branch preference order, click "Continue". Please note that, during counselling, you will be offered available branch as per this preference order and no change will be allowed that time.
15. Next read and accept the declaration and Submit your form. **This step submits and locks your form and no change will be permitted after you Save the declaration.** You will have to pay a non-refundable counselling fee of Rs. 1,500/- from the Pay Fee menu on the left.
16. Download the form and keep with you for future reference. Not filling-up counselling-cum-admission form before the scheduled counselling date/time and/or your absence in counselling on the prescribed date and time will be presumed as "Not Interested" in getting admitted to this Institute and accordingly your candidature will be forfeited for admission automatically. In such case, no requests for further consideration shall be entertained in any form.

17. During the counselling, if all your documents are found okay, you will be offered the available branch based on your preference. If you accept the offer, you will be required to pay the Admission fee ONLINE immediately upon allotment of seat to confirm your admission in NERIST. The Admission fee needs to be paid online by logging into the same account at <https://students.targetx.in/NERIST/login>. We accept all forms of online payment (Credit Card/ Debit Card/ Debit Card+ATM PIN/ Net Banking/ Wallets/ Cash Cards/ UPI (for a full list of supported UPI Apps, refer to <https://www.npci.org.in/what-we-do/upi/live-members>). **No cash payment will be accepted for admission to NERIST.** Non-payment of Admission fee online immediately will vacate your allotted seat and the same will be offered to the next candidate as per merit. You will also need to pay ONLINE Mess Advance of Rs.16,610/- (approx.) and Caution Money of Rs.3,000/- by logging into NERIST ERP (<https://nerist.symphonyx.in/student>) after hostel allotment. We will provide you with the login credentials for NERIST ERP via SMS/email to your registered mobile number/email address after admission.
18. Login to NERIST ERP (<https://nerist.symphonyx.in/student>) for completing remaining works like semester subject registration, downloading study materials, submitting assignments, mess bill payments, etc. Change the default password sent to you upon first login and don't ever share it with anyone. The email address and mobile number you have provided in <https://students.targetx.in/NERIST/login> during counselling form fill-up will be copied to ERP and all information, notices, updates will be sent to you via email and SMS (including OTP for resetting password) to these contacts only. Always keep these updated from your ERP Edit Profile page. Your Roll No. will also be available here on the Semester Registration Acknowledgement Slip that you can download from CBCS menu of the ERP.
19. Attend the Fresher's Orientation Programme on 16th July 2026 at 4:30 PM.
20. Regular Classes will start from 17th July 2026. Attend classes after admission following class timetable available at <https://www.nerist.ac.in/class-timetable>, which will also be available on your ERP dashboard.
